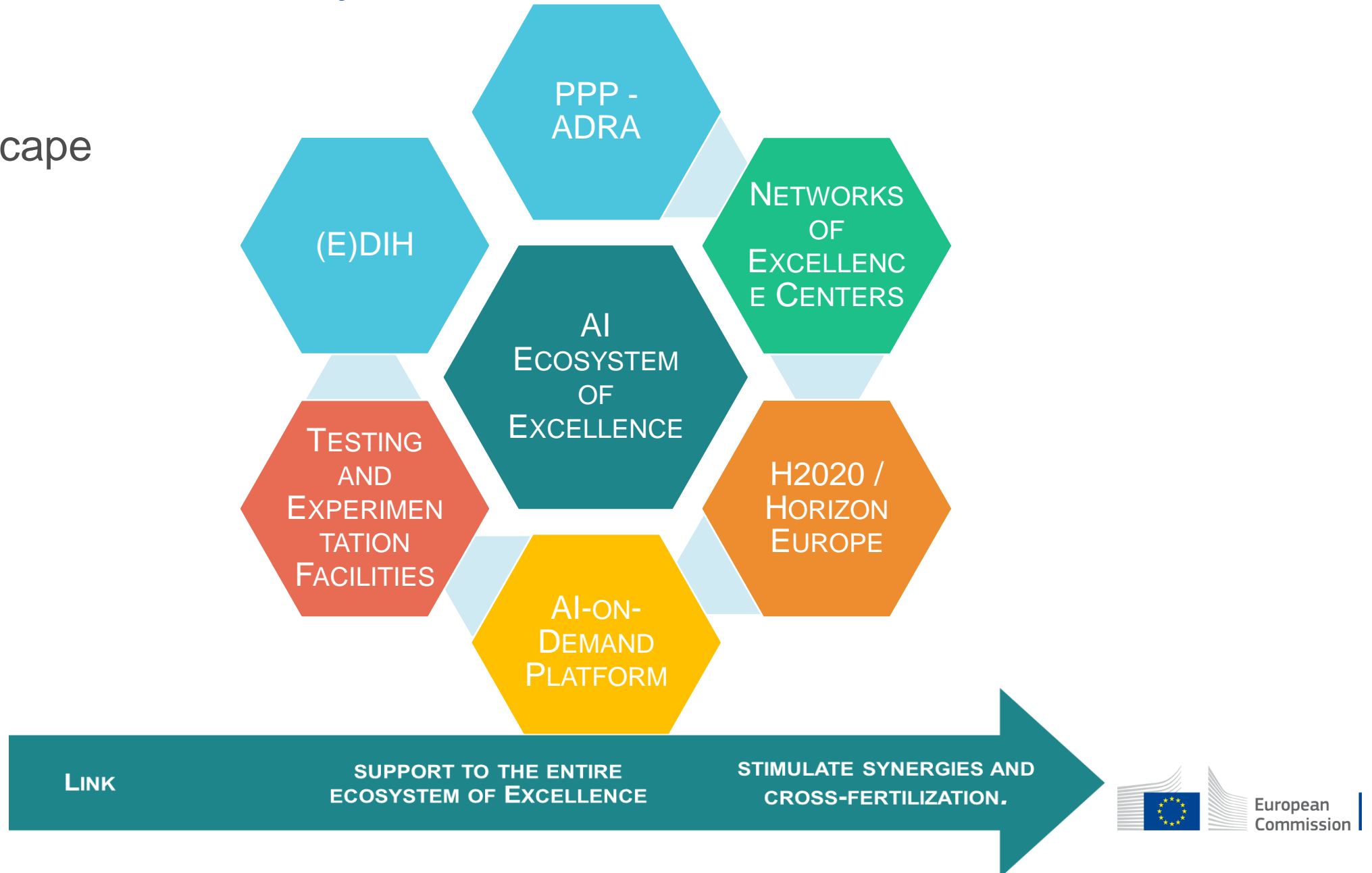

 - *ADR Convergence Summit: convergence of the three disciplines*
 - *ADR Conference: ADR community to identify and share strategic challenges (ERF / BDVA Summit)*
 - *ADR Project Exhibition:*
 - *Showcase*
 - *Outline promising future paths for ADR → RTD funding priorities.*

ADRAe & Ecosystem of Excellence

- *Contribute for the update of the SRIDA*
 - *Specify concrete actions to support the PPP*
 - *Make full use of the results available at the NoEs*
 - *Timing – update of SRIDA has to happen in the coming year → WP 25-26*

ADR Ae & Ecosystem of Excellence

- *ADR landscape*
 - *Benefit for the entire community (network / visibility)*
 - *Make full use of available resources and results, e.g. from the NoEs / Lighthouse*
 - *Implementation – in collaboration with AI4Europe → Make it visible*
- *Given the multiplication of tools and services*
 - *Rationalise*
 - *Work with AI4Europe to create of a common and easy to access repository of tools and service*
 - *Exploit them to develop synergies/collaboration → STRONG COMMUNITY*

ADR Ae & Ecosystem of Excellence

- *Support to standardisation*
- *Support the EC: regulatory framework*
- *CEN-CENELEC selected AI as a use case.*
 - *Adra-e support to CEN-CENELEC is important for the ecosystem of trust*
 - *meeting Adra-e / CEN-CENELEC planned to see how Adra-e could best support standardisation activities.*
